The Media Technology and Innovation Endowment Fund is pleased to offer scholarships to support and encourage students who are working on innovative technologies in the media and entertainment industry, particularly in areas such as virtual reality (VR), augmented reality (AR), and artificial intelligence (AI).

Here's what you need to know.

Number, Value, and Duration of Scholarships

Three scholarships, valued at \$5000 Canadian per year, are available to eligible students. Scholarships are available for bachelor level programs. Scholarship is non-renewable.

Eligibility

You are eligible if you:

- Already enrolled in full-time studies in your first bachelor's degree.
- Have a minimum GPA of 75.
- Are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.

Applicants from underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply

Eligible Institutions

Canadian educational institutions that have recognized degree, diploma granting powers or their affiliates (e.g., universities, colleges)

Fields of Study Program Requirements

Your program of study is restricted to:

- Media Technology, Engineering with a focus on media applications, Digital Media and Interactive Media.
- Computer Science with a media focus including, but not limited to, Computing and Creative Arts, New Media/Computer Science, Computational Media Design, Visual Arts and Computer Science, etc.

University preparatory programs such as CEGEP pre-university diplomas are not eligible. Depending on the curriculum, an applied Bachelor program may be considered either as a university level program or a college level program.

Conditions/Restrictions

- If you start post-secondary studies in January, you are eligible for the summer competition of the same year.
- You must be already enrolled at the undergraduate level.
- You are eligible to receive the award a maximum of two times.
- **Universities Canada** retains the right to change or end the sponsorship of the scholarship plan without notice.

How to Apply?

To apply for the scholarship, please submit an online application no later than **June 4, 2025, at 1 PM EST** by visiting https://portal.scholarshippartners.ca

Required Documents:

- Both an academic and an extracurricular reference form from someone not related to you.
- Transcripts of the last three terms of available marks.
- And an essay describing your passion for media technology and innovation, your career goals, and how you plan to contribute to the media and entertainment industry.

Detailed instructions can be found in the application. Remember, your application must be complete to be evaluated, and deadline extensions will not be granted.

Evaluation Criteria

Applications are assessed on academic performance; volunteer/community involvement and/or extracurricular activities; and content and relevance of reference letters.

Selection Process

A committee of Canadian university and college representatives, chosen by Scholarship Partners Canada (SPC), selects scholarship recipients. The selection committee's decisions are final.

All applicants will receive results of the selection process by email.

Successful Applicants

You will receive scholarship confirmation in **August**. When you receive your confirmation, complete the online acceptance process and submit any necessary documentation, which includes proof of registration from your educational institution.

Scholarship Payment

Payment will be made after the acceptance process and document review. It can take 6 to 8 weeks, depending on the method of payment chosen. Funds will be sent to your educational institution on behalf of the sponsor.

Please make sure to pay your tuition fees within the defined time frame, regardless of the timing of scholarship payment. Your institution will reimburse you according to their normal practices.

We will communicate with you through your student portal account. Be sure to keep contact information up to date and to notify us of any changes.
