

Atlantic Packaging (AP) is proud to be an employer and values the dedication of every employee and the tremendous support of their families. To give back to the extended AP community, an academic scholarship program has been established to support the next generation of thought leaders and help ensure a successful start to their careers.

Here's what you need to know.

Eligibility

You are eligible if:

- You are a dependent child of a parent or guardian who is a regular full-time employee of Atlantic Packaging, with at least two years of service, and who is actively employed as of the scholarship award date.
- You are enrolled in, or planning to enroll in, full-time studies in your first postsecondary bachelor's degree or diploma program.
- You are under the age of 25 at the start of the academic year.
- You are currently in high school, with a minimum cumulative average of 75% (or equivalent) in your Grade 11 and Grade 12 academic courses available at the time of application. Non-academic courses, such as career studies or personal development-related courses, will not be considered.
- You are currently enrolled in a college or university program, with a minimum cumulative average of 75% (or equivalent GPA) in your most recent academic year of study.

Value and Duration of Scholarships

Up to 10 scholarships, each valued at up to \$3,500 CAD per year, are available to eligible students.

Scholarships are available for bachelor's degree or diploma-level programs and can be renewed annually for the normal duration of the program, up to a maximum of four years, or until the recipient earns their first bachelor's degree or diploma, whichever occurs first.

Students who apply while already enrolled in a postsecondary program may receive funding only for the remaining years of their first bachelor's degree or diploma program, with total funding limited to a maximum of four years.

Eligible Institutions

You may study at any Canadian or U.S. educational institution that is officially recognized and authorized to grant degrees or diplomas, including universities, colleges, and CEGEPs (Collège d'enseignement général et professionnel/College of General and Vocational Education).

Fields of Study

Your program of study can be in any field or discipline and must have a minimum duration of two years for university programs or one year for college programs.

University preparatory programs, such as CEGEP pre-university diplomas are not eligible. Depending on the curriculum and institution, an applied Bachelor's program may be considered either as a university-level program or a college-level program.

Conditions/Restrictions

- Students who have previously held an Atlantic Packaging Academic Scholarship and have received the maximum support available under the program are not eligible to apply.
- To be eligible to receive the scholarship, the student's AP parent or guardian must be an active full-time employee of Atlantic Packaging with at least two years of service at the time the scholarship recipients are announced and must remain actively employed at the time of each annual renewal.
- If the AP parent or guardian's employment is terminated during the year in which their dependent is scheduled to receive scholarship funding, the scholarship will be terminated, and no payment will be made.
- The scholarship will be suspended if the student does not maintain full-time enrolment, does not achieve a minimum average of 75% (or equivalent) for the academic year under review, or does not complete the renewal process by the specified deadline. For renewal purposes, grades from supplementary or repeated examinations taken in the same academic year, including summer sessions, will be considered in determining the student's average.

- The scholarship will be terminated if the student withdraws from their program
- Following a scholarship suspension, the student may be reassessed for renewal after completing one full academic year at their own expense while maintaining full-time status and a minimum 75% average (or equivalent) in all courses.
- Changing field of study, program level or institution does not affect eligibility, provided the student remains enrolled full-time and continues to meet all program requirements.
- Requests for one-year deferrals will be considered in exceptional circumstances, such as illness, accident, or death in the family. Deferral requests must be submitted to Universities Canada as soon as the situation arises. Supporting documentation may be requested before the deferral is approved.
- Atlantic Packaging retains the right to modify or terminate the Atlantic Packaging Academic Scholarship program at any time without notice.

How to apply?

To apply for the scholarship, please submit an online application no later than **May 14, 2026, 1:00 PM EST** by visiting <https://portal.scholarshippartners.ca/welcome/AtlanticPackagingEN/>

Access the dependent scholarship program using the company code: **336ATP2026**

Required documents

- Employee Consent Form completed by the Atlantic Packaging employee.
- Two reference forms, one academic form and one extracurricular or community involvement form, each from individuals not related to you.
- Official Transcript:
 - **Secondary school applicants:** An official secondary school transcript showing Grade 11 and Grade 12 course grades available at the time of application. Home school grades will only be accepted if validated through a recognized independent evaluation process.

- **University/college applicants:** An official post-secondary transcript showing all courses and grades completed to date.

- An essay detailing your educational and career goals. How do you plan to achieve them, and how will the scholarship support your aspirations? Highlight your proudest accomplishments and how they have influenced your goals. (350 words maximum)
- A resume outlining the applicant's education, extracurricular activities, work experience and/or volunteer experience.

Evaluation criteria

The selection process will be based on the strength of each applicant's submission and supporting documentation.

Selection Process

Atlantic Packaging will convene a selection committee to review the applications and select recipients.

Applicants will receive the results of the selection process by email. You may be contacted by Scholarship Partners Canada or Atlantic Packaging for additional information if required.

All decisions made by the selection committee are final and not subject to appeal.

Successful Applicants

Successful applicants will receive a scholarship confirmation in August. Once confirmation is received, recipients must complete the online acceptance award process, and submit any required documentation, which includes a photo, a biography and a proof of registration from your educational institution.

Scholarship Payment

Payment will be made after the acceptance process and document review are completed. Processing may take 6 to 8 weeks, depending on the method of payment chosen. Funds will be sent directly to the recipient's educational institution on behalf of Atlantic Packaging.

Please ensure that you pay your tuition fees by the required deadlines, regardless of the timing of the scholarship payment. Your institution will reimburse you according to their normal practices once they receive the scholarship funds.

We will communicate with you through your student portal account. Be sure to keep contact information up to date and to notify us of any changes.
