

Pathways Scholarship Disbursement Guide for Students

INTRODUCTION:

Pathways to Education scholarships are designed to support students as they transition to postsecondary study or employment. Scholarship funds can be applied to post-secondary expenses, which are defined as fees for provincially regulated CEGEP (Collège d'enseignement general et professionnel) college, university, professional school, post-secondary preparedness programs, high school upgrading program, apprenticeship, or trade programs.

All Pathways scholarships are dependent on funding availability.

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

A student must have been active in the Pathways program for a minimum of two, non-consecutive academic years.

Students may access their scholarship anytime until December 31st of the year that they turn 23 years of age. All unused scholarship balances will be forfeited following this date.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENTS

All scholarship payments are sent directly to the Student Awards & Financial Aid Office (or equivalent) at an academic institution. It is the post-secondary institutions discretion if the scholarship funds can be applied to other academic expenses, such as books and supplies.

In order to access scholarship funds a student must have either a confirmed letter of acceptance, a conditional letter of acceptance, tuition bill or proof of attendance in post-secondary.

The maximum amount of scholarship payments requested for one year of a multi-year program is \$2000. The amount requested cannot exceed the remaining scholarship balance.

Students with a balance after their first full year may use their remaining scholarship funds for continued study post-secondary.

Students enrolled in a one-year program may use their full scholarship balance in year one of post-secondary.
